

Beginning on August 17, Lincoln Preparatory School will host REQUIRED Orientation Days for the 2020-2021 School Year. The Orientation Days will be for one group of students per day. 3. Meet their teachers and paraprofessionals
4. Review the curriculums and programs that will be used during the 2020-2021 school year
5. Set up transportation
6. Purchase/Order Uniforms
7. Check out technology devices (1 per student)
8. Complete any unfinished enrollment packets
9. Pick up Class schedules
10. Receive Google Classroom Codes and Remind Codes for all Teachers
11. Take School Identification Pictures
12. Virtual Students will pick up their print material books needed for class
13. Receive their login credentials for all programs used during the 2020-2021 school year
14. Sign the necessary documents for virtual learning
15. Sign dual enrollment documents
16. Review testing schedule
17. Set up contact information for teachers
18. Sign health care forms
19. Learn how to use the virtual learning platform Google Classroom
